How to Get Around



Public transportation is limited in Orlando. You'll need a car if you intend to explore.

Avoid I-4, Orlando's main thoroughfare, during rush hours, which run from 6:30 to 9 a.m. and 3 to 6:30 p.m. Instead, take a toll road, like I-417, I-429, I-528 or the Florida Turnpike.

The I-Ride Trolley operates throughout the International Drive Resort area, stopping at many attractions and shopping destinations. Kids 12 and under ride free with a paying adult.
